## **Trash**

- Food Waste: Leftover food, food scraps, and peels.
- Plastics: Plastic bags, utensils, and Styrofoam.
- Paper: Soiled or wax-coated paper, printer paper, napkins, and tissues.
- Glass: Glass bottles and jars.
- General Waste: Basic office/restaurant trash.

## **Prohibited**

- Construction Materials: Wood, paints, ballasts, dirt roofing, brick, stones, sand, concrete, granite, or soil.
- **Hazardous Waste:** Batteries, medical waste, asbestos, freon, chemicals, oils, and chemicals.
- **Misc:** Tires, large appliances, furniture, barrels, fieworks, mattresses, furniture, trees, branches, and wood pallets.

\*All materials listed above are non-compactable materials that can damage our trucks or ignite a fire when compacted.

## **Service Tips:**

- Make sure not blocked, locked or items in front of dumpster.
- Confirm lids shut and not overloaded, no items hanging or sticking out.

## Recycling Bin

Newspapers, magazines, office paper, and cartons.

Clean plastic bottles, containers with no lids.

No coated cardboard boxes

Aluminum cans, steel cans, and empty aerosol cans.

## Trash Bin

Leftover food, food scraps, and peels.

Plastic bags, utensils, and Styrofoam.

Soiled or wax-coated paper, napkins, and tissues.





## RECYCLING ORDISPOSAL



### **Trash**

- Food Waste: Leftover food, food scraps, and peels.
- Non-Recyclable Plastics: Plastic bags, utensils, and Styrofoam.
- Non-Recyclable Paper: Soiled or wax-coated paper, napkins, and tissues.
- Hazardous Waste: Batteries, electronics, chemicals, and sharp objects.
- · Glass: Glass bottles and jars.
- · General Waste: Items not suitable for recycling.

## **Recycling**

- Paper: Newspapers, magazines, office paper, cardboard boxes, and cartons.
- Plastics: Clean plastic bottles, containers w/ no lids.
- Metal: Aluminum cans, steel cans, and empty
- aerosol cans.



- Rinse containers before recycling.
- · Break down boxes to save space
